

Federal Income Tax Credits for Energy Efficiency

ENERGY STAR products eligible for tax credits are independently certified to save energy, save money and protect the environment. Use up to 30% less energy in your home by outfitting it with ENERGY STAR products available across more than 70 categories.

Tax Credit: 30% of cost with no upper limit
Expires: December 31, 2021

*Tax credits for Solar Energy Systems are available
at 30% through December 31, 2019.*

*The credit decreases to 26% for tax year 2020;
drops to 22% for tax year 2021 then
expires December 31, 2021.*

Details: Existing homes and new construction qualify.
Both principal residences and second homes qualify.
Rentals **do not** qualify.

Solar Energy Systems

What's Required?

Energy tax credits require an ***ENERGY STAR qualified product*** to reduce the amount of energy used to condition the building's interior living space. These products are metal roofs with appropriate pigmented coatings and asphalt roofs with appropriate cooling granules.

How to Qualify:

You'll need to fill out the ***Tax Form 5695*** and print off a copy of the ***Manufacturer's Certification Statement***.
